The adopted horse that will be kept at your facility will need:

For a Standardbred 6-7lbs of 12% feed along with 1/4 – 1/2 of a bale of hay a day.

For a Thoroughbred 8-10lbs of 12% feed along with 1/4 – 1/2 of a bale of hay a day.

If the horse is getting over weight or under weight only then can their feed be adjusted. For the next two years if the horse is mistreated or under fed the horse will need to be returned to New Vocations. This is all verified in the contract the adopter signed. If at any-time the boarder misses a board bill please contact us ASAP. We will pick up the horse and pay one month's bill only. If you ever have any concerns for the horse's condition or situation please contact us.
